## **Remarks by Most Reverend Walter A. Hurley on the recent Supreme Court ruling regarding the use of Federally Controlled Drugs for Assisted Suicide**

*“The recent Supreme Court decision on the Oregon Case ruled that Congress has not delegated to the U.S attorney general the authority to prevent federally controlled drugs from being used for physician-assisted suicide. The ruling does not resolve the legal or moral issues regarding physician-assisted suicide, though it does uphold Oregon’s law on physician-assisted suicide.*

*We continue to oppose legislation or actions that do not uphold the dignity and sanctity of life.”*
